## PLAYING SCHEDULE - MEN'S SENIOR DIVISION

### PLAYING SCHEDULE AND PLAYOFFS

The detailed playing schedule for both Group A and B is attached. Please note that there are no games for your division on June 9 and 25 because there are no fields available.

The top four teams from each group qualify for the playoffs. There is no room in the schedule to expand the playoffs to the top eight teams this year.

Standings are based on total points accumulated during round-robin play (3 - win, 1 - tie). In case of a tie in the standings, the following will be used to break the tie:

1. Head-to-head competition
2. Goal differential (GF - GA)
3. Least goals allowed
4. Most goals scored
5. Coin flip.



The teams will be paired-off as shown on the attached playoff draw.

Note: The letter 'A' designates the 6:00 p.m. Group, and the letter 'B' designates the 7:15 p.m. Group. The numbers represent the standings after completion of round-robin play. For example, 'A1' is the team that finished 1st in Group A (6:00 p.m.), 'B1' is the team that finished 1st in Group B (7:15 p.m.), etc.

The playoff dates are July 14, 16 and 21, 2009. Please note that no fields are available at Lehigh on July 7 - 9.

### **PARKING, SPEEDING & TAILGATING**

Please tell your players that they should park only in the designated parking areas. Please remind the players when arriving and departing the fields to obey speed limits in and around the parking lots, there is a lot of foot traffic and we want to avoid accidents due to reckless driving.

At NCC, spectators or players may stay and view activities from either side of the fields, but must not climb the fence to enter any of the neighbors' property. Suggestion: if the ball goes over the fence, please go around the block and ring the bell at the front of the house and ask permission to retrieve the ball from the property.

Tailgating at Lehigh is limited to the parking lots; no alcohol is allowed on or next to the fields. No kegs or bottles, only cans. Legal drinking age of 21 years of age is strictly enforced. Site (fields and parking lot) must be cleaned up prior to leaving. We have to vacate campus at dusk or at 9:00 PM, so plan accordingly.

Tailgating is not allowed at Northampton Community College, therefore, no alcoholic beverages shall be consumed in the parking lots.

### **GAME POSTPONEMENT**

We update it daily by 4:30 p.m. We will make an effort to reschedule postponed games using the available dates for the whole league. Please note that these are Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays. Fields are not available in late July, so we cannot extend the season.

### **IN CASE OF EMERGENCY OR INJURY**

In case of injury or other medical emergency, please see the Trainer on duty at Lehigh and the league representative at NCC. He/she is located inside or near the traffic circle at Lehigh unless attending an injury. The fields are spread out but one of us, Ed or Kal, should be around the fields, and will assist with the injury. The Trainer or the league representative will call for an ambulance in case of serious injury.
